**ENTRIES**



1. All Coconino County Parks & Recreation (CCPR) All-Park Rules and Policies apply.
2. Trailers and vehicles must be parked a minimum of twenty (20) feet away from all barns. In order to alleviate congestion and provide for smooth traffic flow at the stables, a designated parking area for vehicles and trailers may be assigned by the Stable Manager or the Events Coordinator during times of high use.
3. Renters must clean stall(s) daily and manure must be placed in designated collection areas.
4. No stalls shall be used for any purpose other than for housing horses, livestock, tack or feed.
5. Horses may not be tied to trees, fencing, buildings or trailers. All horses within stables area must be stalled.
6. All horses stabled on park premises must be stabled in permanent stalls, arranged through the Stable Manager.
7. Only one horse will be allowed in each stall or pen (except for mare with foal).
8. Camping in the stable area is permitted for those caring for a stabled animal. Fees will be charged as per the current Fort Tuthill County Park Fee Schedule and all camping rules apply.
9. The Stable Manager assigns stalls and/or barns. Event coordinators may assign stalls once the Stable Manager has assigned barns for the event.
10. Shavings are preferred bedding and may be purchased at Stable Office. Shavings may not be sold by any other concession within Fort Tuthill County Park facilities unless contracted through CCPR management.
11. Removal and disposal of dead animals is the responsibility of the owner. Notification and cause of death must be provided to Stable Manager. If cause of death is not immediately apparent, a licensed veterinarian must be obtained at the expense of the owner of the animal to determine if death was infectious in nature and if notification must be provided to the State Veterinarian. The owner of the deceased animal will be liable for any costs associated with disinfecting the stall area.
12. Electricity is not available in stalls or barns. Electric is available for grooming purposes only and an electrical key is available for check-out with the Stable Manager. Fees apply.
13. Personal property may not remain in the stable premises after conclusion of stall rental period.
14. For security purposes, the east gate of the stable area will be locked at dusk and opened at 6:00 a.m. except one week prior and during the annual horserace meet. Modified hours for this period will be posted.
15. Quiet time in the stable area is from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
16. Dogs must be on leash at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
17. The speed limit throughout the stables area is 5 miles per hour.
18. Failure to follow rules and procedures may result in eviction or removal from the park.

## **RULES FOR THE ACADEMY DIVISION & RULES FOR THE SCHOOLING CLASSES**

### **General:**

1. Horses are not judged. Horses in the Academy classes must be lesson horses used regularly in a professionally operated lesson program. These horses must display the characteristics of such.
2. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the rider to control and show their horses to the best advantage.
3. Academy Equitation classes are judged on basic equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads.
4. Academy Showmanship classes should be judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. The horse is not supposed to be judged. It should be judged on the rider's ability to control and show their horse. Promptness in finding the correct diagonals and canter leads are important as well as the rider's command of the horse; for example, speed, placement in the ring and collection.
5. Headers are allowed in the 9 & 10 and 8 & Under Walk/Trot classes only after the judges' cards have been turned in. No towels, whips or aids of any kind are allowed.
6. Disputes shall be submitted in writing to Show Management, whose decisions are final.

## **RULES FOR THE ACADEMY DIVISION & RULES FOR THE SCHOOLING CLASSES**

**Riders:**

1. No full riding suits allowed (no hats, derbies, or jackets). Neat Jodhpurs with dress shirt and Jodhpur boots are required. Vest and tie are optional. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. Helmets required for exhibitors age 17 and under.
2. Riders must be participating in a professionally operated program and show on lesson horses.
3. A rider may own his/her horse as long as the horse is regularly used in a lesson program.
4. A rider who has shown in a regular division or in a full suit is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of Show Rider Practice.
5. Once a rider has shown in Walk/Trot/Canter classes, a return to Walk/Trot classes is prohibited. You cannot show in Walk/Trot/Canter and Walk/Trot at the same show.
6. Academy riders may not show in any other division at the same show with the exception of driving classes.

**Horses:**

1. Horses must be flat/keg shod. Corrective shoeing will be allowed without excessive pads. Soundness is not to be considered.
2. Horses may be shown in snaffle bridles with martingales. Pelham and curb type bits (martingales discouraged) are allowed at the discretion of the instructor. Please use caution when biting horses for beginners. Flat cutback English type saddles are to be used, unless the class calls for alternative tack, such as Western or Hunt.
3. Academy horses may be cross-entered into show divisions at the same show. Show horses (horses not used in a professional lesson program and shown regularly in show performance or equitation classes) may not be cross-entered into the Academy Division.

**MISC 10 AND UNDER RIDER SCHOOLING CLASSES ANY BREED**

Riders never to have shown in a full suit.

Riders never to have shown in a canter class.

Rider attire:

Jodhpurs, Dress shirt, Jodhpur boots, Helmet.

Vest and tie optional. No jackets or derbies.

Horse may be shown in a double or snaffle bridle.

Online riders to be led by a responsible adult.

**Pattern Practice Class Conduct:**

1. Pattern Practice classes are offered for Academy only riders and an Open class-open to any rider, academy or non academy. Riders that have not cantered in the show ring should enter the W&T pattern practice class! Pattern may or may not be posted prior to the start of the session in the horse show office. There will be no rail work, only individually conducted patterns. Riders will be worked in order of their exhibitor numbers and will report to the in gate of the arena and place their horses at the direction of the judge when the class is called to order by the announcer. Judges will select from USEF Tests 1-15.

**UPHA Challenge Cup Qualifying Class:** Riders must be members of UPHA, visit UPHA online.com for membership and class conduct and rules.
